To be judged on presentation of the animal to the judge, neatness and appearance of the handler, overall condition of the animal, handling techniques, appropriate tack and equipment, demonstration of correct training and ability to show horse to the best of its ability.

**GENERAL INFORMATION****LEVELS**

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Management reserves right to combine, divide, or cancel any class, except as limited by this Prize List. There will be a lunch break and separate breaks as judge requires.

## AWARDS

6 ribbons will be presented in each class except in championship classes. Special champion and reserve ribbons, trophies, or sashes will be awarded to championship classes. MWW Grand Championship of breed show will receive facility sponsored plate.

## ENTRIES

**Separate entries are required for each show.** An Entry is a Rider / Handler and Horse combination. Each Entry requires a separate Entry Form. A separate Bridle Number is issued to each Entry.

## ENTRY FORMS

Remit Entries via mail to Show Secretary ONLY – Show Manager cannot process your entry. All entries MUST submit USEF and USDF documents for handler/rider, owner, and horse, a drug fee, and non-refundable office fee. No entry accepted without a negative Coggins dated within 12 months of show. Every horse (except foals under 6 months) must supply non-returnable copy of Negative coggins that has been done within one year of show date. Competitors must be in good financial standing with MWW prior to entry acceptance. No exceptions. It is STRONGLY recommended that you have your horses up-to-date on all vaccinations.

## INCOMPLETE OR LATE ENTRIES

No refunds for competitor entry errors. Show Secretary reserves the right to delay processing of any incomplete Entry Form(s) until all required information (including required breed registration documentation), signatures and payment are complete. Incomplete Entry Forms may thereby lose priority for “first come, first serve” processing mentioned in this prize list; they may fall onto Wait List; they may be required to pay late fees (per the above table) at the point Entry Form is complete; they may lose priority for stabling. “First come / first serve” policies may be applied depending on point at which Entry Form is complete, not point at which Entry Form is received by Show Secretary. An entry is considered “post entry” at midnight Friday July 29, 2011 and will incur a \$100 fee after that time to enter the show.

## PAYMENT WITH ENTRY

Entry form will not be processed without full payment. We are accepting credit cards (MC/VISA) provided a detailed summary of fees is included. Make checks out to Maplewood Warmbloods; checks (including those on Wait List) will be deposited upon receipt. Competitor is responsible for non-negotiable check fees of \$35.

## COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

The Maplewood Warmbloods website ([www.maplewoodwarmbloods.com](http://www.maplewoodwarmbloods.com)) will be used to keep show competitors informed by posting show as it is filling and after scheduling when times are set. Check under the “news” page.

Entries confirmations will NOT be mailed. Instead, Show Manager shall post details of each class, as show fills, on the Maplewood website. Check all information carefully and notify Entry Secretary immediately of errors. No guarantee of show reporting corrections and additional information given after Closing Date.

Written Notification consists of: (1) notification to Show Secretary (preferred) or Show Manager by email and (2) reply by email or fax from Show Secretary or Show Manager. No changes or refunds will be processed without both (1) and (2) above. Keep your paperwork. To be safe send all written communications to both Show Secretary and Show Manager.

Class tests and awards not picked up during the show will not be mailed to competitor. Competitor forfeits awards not picked up. If you are not available, have a friend pick them up.

## CHANGES / REFUNDS

Scratches may be only done by:

- (1) Forfeiting the Time Slot = no refund.
- (2) Adds may be only done by: Filling an available Time Slot or placement on Wait List, in either case by paying full entry fee. In addition, any Change or Add that requires issuance of new Bridle Number will be charged a reprocess fee of \$30 (on or before Close Date) or \$100 (after close Date and at show).

Any refund monies will be mailed after show to the person listed as Owner on Entry. Full refunds, except for Office Fee & stabling scratch fee available through Closing Date only with Written Notification (email, fax, US mail) to Show Secretary (with preferably copy to Show Manager) and with written receipt from Secretary. There will be no refunds after Closing Date for any reason. No refunds for expulsion from show; elimination from class(es). No refunds for competitor error(s). No refunds for cancellation of Event, portion(s) of Event and / or class(es) for any reason including (but not exclusively) situations resulting from: grounds (or portion of grounds) unavailable / unusable to Maplewood Warmbloods show management for any reason; inclement weather; Acts of God; local / national emergency, or act(s) of terrorism.

## STABLING

A limited number of permanent 12 x 12 stalls with doors available for \$150. Remaining competitors will be in temporary 10x10 stabling with doors. No cleaning deposit required. Tack stalls available upon request for \$150. Breed show competitors arriving Thur and vacating by 4pm Friday will only be charged \$100. The farm will open to breed show competitors on Thursday, August 4, 2009 after 2:00 PM. Stabling will be open to dressage competitors Friday 4pm. PLEASE DO NOT COME BEFORE THIS TIME – your stall may not be available. Horses must vacate the facility by 9:00 PM on Sunday. Make arrangements with farm management if you need to be outside these hours. YOU ARE FINANCIALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE YOU OR YOUR HORSE CAUSES TO THE FACILITY.

## STABLING RULES AND INFORMATION

Power (110V only) is available. All electrical cords must be 12 gauge, 3-wire negative ground with connections conforming to state and county codes. No cords to be run across driveways or walkways or where horses & people will be walking. No Class I Flammable Liquids such as gasoline are NOT allowed inside any buildings or tents neither on the grounds, nor anywhere (inside or outside buildings) in the stabling areas. No gas, electric or propane heaters, tanks or hot plates (inside or outside

buildings) are allowed in the stabling areas. Sharps boxes will be located in stabling area per USEF requirements.

No bedding, dishes, buckets etc will be provided. Shavings can be purchased on-site for \$8 per bag. Night watch will be provided 6:00 PM until 6:00 AM at show expense. Full refunds before Closing Date. After Closing refund of all stabling fees (except \$100 Stabling Scratch Fee per stall), only when competitor notifies Secretary by Written Notification on or before Closing Date. After Closing Date, no refunds, no exceptions (including weather).

## OTHER INFORMATION

*\*\*This is a private farm. Please be respectful of the premises including its buildings, facilities, and grounds. There will be no motorized vehicles (ie. Motorcycles, golf carts, quads, go carts, etc). Electric Golf Carts are acceptable provided the driver has a valid license (See GR901.29). Handicapped wheelchairs are exempt. No one without a driver's license permitted to drive any vehicle on the premises. Please clean up after yourselves, be respectful of other competitors and people on the site. If there's anything that can be done to make your show weekend more enjoyable please do not hesitate to ask a MWW representative (they will have MWW apparel on). Please have a great weekend full of fun, safety, honesty, respectfulness, and friendly competition. Please accept our sincere appreciation for your attendance. Good luck!\*\**

## FOOTING

Breed Show will be held in 80' x 200' new indoor arena with dust free footing, which can be heated if necessary. Dressage Shows will be held solely in the outdoor arena. The indoor arena might be used for dressage show warm-up if ring 2 is being used for the show. **BE RESPECTFUL OF THE FOOTING BY NOT MASHING IN POOP. STAFF WILL BE PICKING ALL DAY IN THE INDOOR should we choose to use it for warm up.** There is no lunging in the indoor arena. Please use round pens or contact staff for field lunging.

## HOSPITALITY & VENDORS

Food and vendors available on site. Please support them.

**VET & FARRIER** - Veterinarian and Farrier will be on-call throughout the competition. Access numbers posted at Headquarters and stabling area.

## ADMISSION TO EVENT

No auditor admission fees. You must however, be in good standing with MWW and/or the USDF/USEF to audit or enter and be on the premises.
